


# Command Codes

---

## ***What is a Command Code?***

- A way to navigate R/3 without using the User Menu.
- A two or three digit value, usually beginning with a forward slash (/), that performs functions like opening or closing sessions and transactions.
- Most command codes can be used alone or with a four-digit transaction code as outlined below.

## ***How Do I Use a Command Code?***

1. Enter a command code (by itself or in front of a Transaction Code) in the Command field.
2. Click on the  **Enter** button or press **Enter** to move directly to the initial transaction screen.

## ***What are Commonly Used Command Codes?***

*Note:*        **xxxx** = insert a transaction code

<b>/Nxxxx</b>	Ends current transaction and starts new transaction (within the same session)
<b>/Oxxxx</b>	<b>Opens</b> session and starts new transaction. Maintains current transactions / sessions
<b>/N</b>	Ends current transaction within a session Returns to SAP R/3 System screen
<b>/O</b>	Displays all current sessions / transactions Provides option to open new session Provides option to close a session
<b>/Nend</b>	Logs off SAP R/3
<b>/I</b>	Ends current transaction and returns to previous transaction (within the same session)
<b>SU3</b>	Opens User Information Maintenance screen <b>(System → User Profile → Own Data)</b> See the Setting User Profile section.
